Another Florida City is facing corrupt charges on its financial budgeting of funds. The City of Hollywood was cited by the state for inappropriate funding and management of its budges and will be audited. This comes after the city declared a financial urgency laying off employees and reducing salaries from 7.5 to 12.5 percent.
